

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

Position Title:	Flying Fox Dispersal Officers (Casuals and Volunteers)
Vaccinations:	Successful candidates who will be involved closely with the flying fox community will require a series of vaccinations to protect against Australian Bat Lyssavirus.
Hours of Work:	Multiple part time candidates could be required for early morning starts (possibly 3.30am). It is expected shifts will be for a minimum of 2 hours and up to 6 hours each day. Dispersal activities will occur 7 days per week over a number of months (and possibly, to a lesser extent, over a number of years) and casual staff will be required to cover this time. It is not expected that each staff member will work 7 days per week and we will be gathering information about each person's availability. It is important that team members can commit to the length of the project.
Location:	Based at various locations in bat colonies in Batemans Bay. Transport to and from work locations will be the successful candidates' own responsibility.
